

# 24<sup>TH</sup> BLAST FURNACE IRONMAKING COURSE

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### TRANSPORTATION

- The nearest large airport to Hamilton is Pearson International in Toronto. For those arriving at Pearson Airport, ground transportation is available with Airways Transit. The trip to Hamilton takes about one hour.
- Hamilton's Munroe Airport is only a few minutes' drive to McMaster.
- There are also flights from many US points to Buffalo or Niagara International Airports. Approximately 120 km (75 mi) to Hamilton.

### UNIVERSITY PARKING:

- Those staying in Les Prince Hall - designated parking lots are: **Lot H & Under the David Braley Athletic Centre** (Use Sterling Street entrance)
- Daily commuters - designated parking lot is **Lot I**. (Use Main Street Entrance).
- If you **already** paid, you will be issued a conference parking permit.
- When entering any of the designated parking lots, you will get a parking permit. Bring this parking permit with you to the registration to exchange it for your already paid conference parking permit. This conference parking permit will allow for in and out privileges all week long.

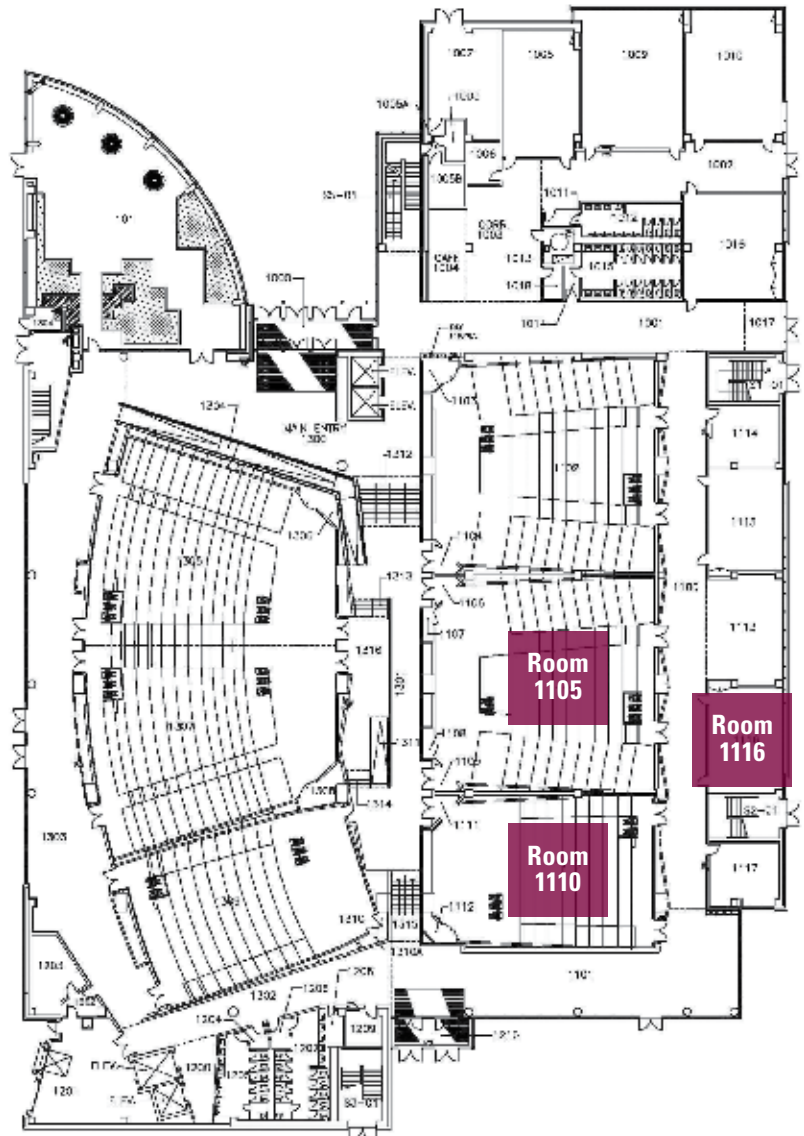

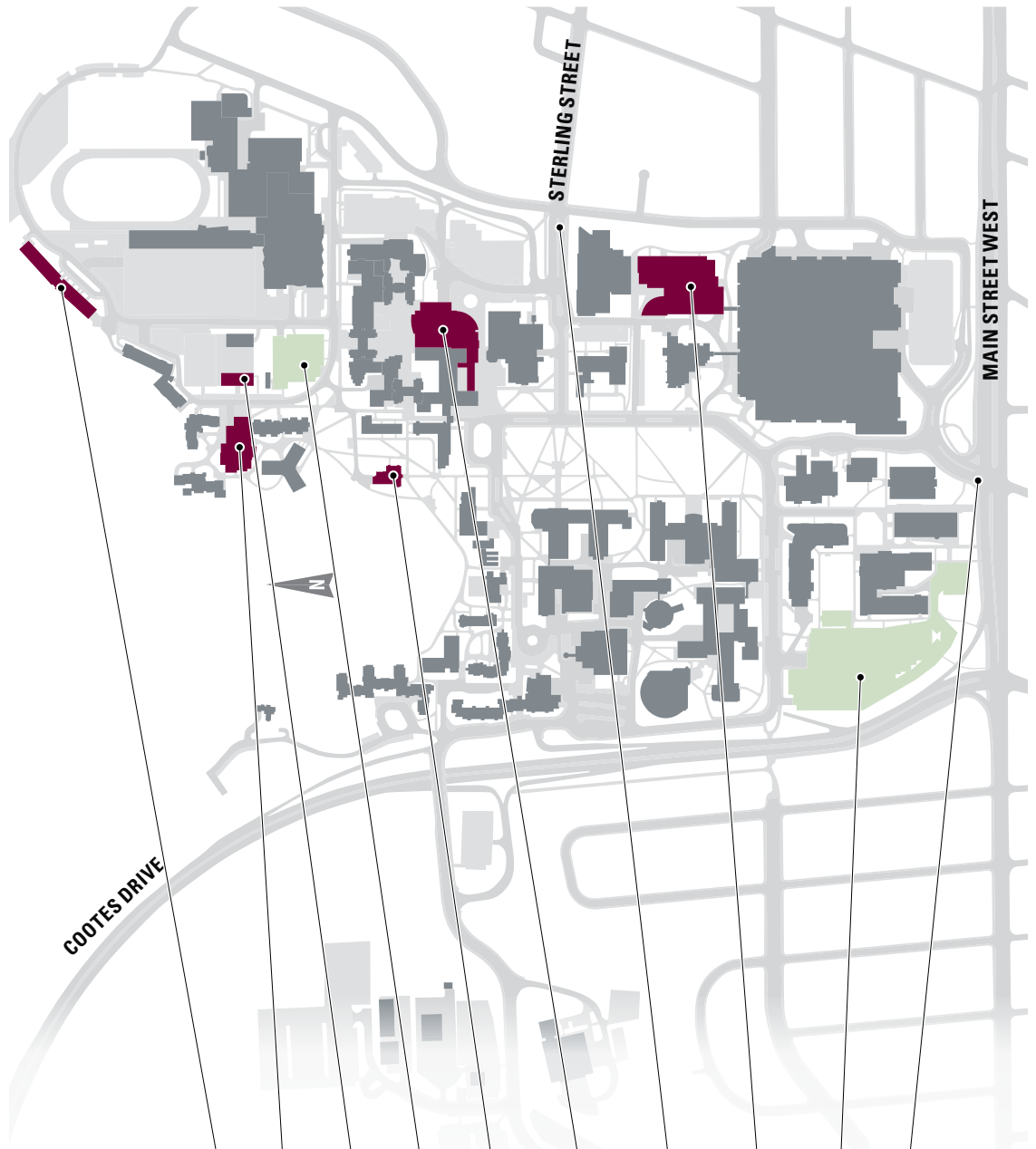
