GENERAL INFORMATION

TRANSPORTATION

- The nearest large airport to Hamilton is Pearson International in Toronto. For those arriving at Pearson Airport, ground transportation is available with Airways Transit. The trip to Hamilton takes about one hour. <http://www.airwaystransit.com/about.shtml>.
- Hamilton's Munroe Airport is only a few minutes' drive to McMaster.
- There are also flights from many US points to Buffalo or Niagara International Airports. Approximately 120 km (75 mi) to Hamilton.

UNIVERSITY PARKING:

- At the day of the course registration, **if you already paid**, you will receive a **rebate ticket**. This rebate ticket will be used to pay for parking charges for the complete week in any parking lot where there is availability. Do not bend or fold this ticket.
 - When you arrive on campus, proceed towards the lot you want to park in.
 - Take a ticket from the entry gate.
 - When you are ready to leave, insert the **rebate ticket** at the entry gate ticket slot. The gate will rise and you can exit the lot.
 - Use the **rebate ticket** to get **in and out** from the parking lots for the rest of the week.
 - We have designated parking lots, but your rebate ticket will be valid on all parking lots, but parking lot A

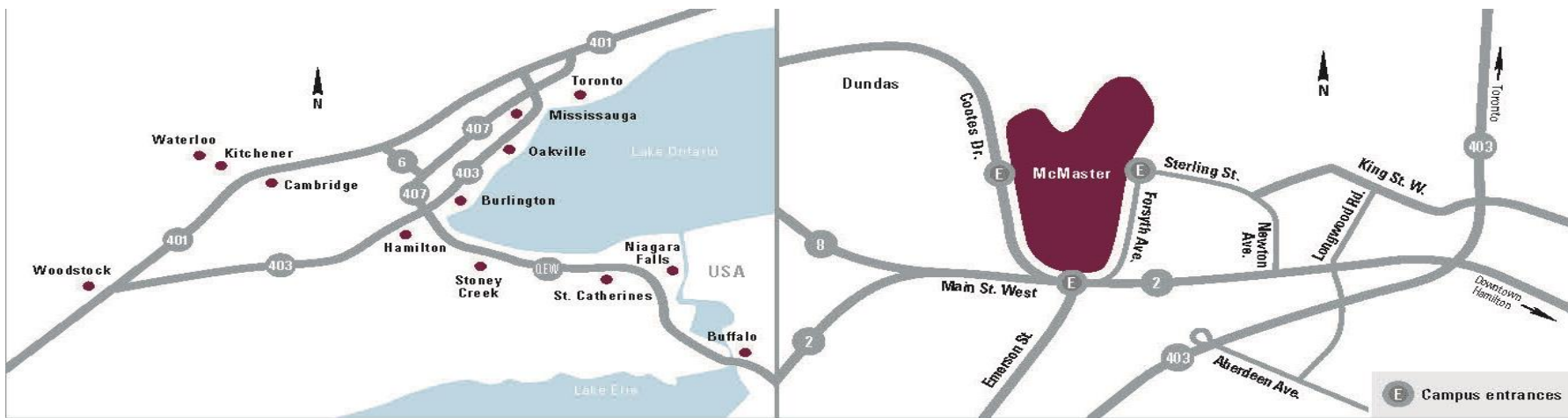

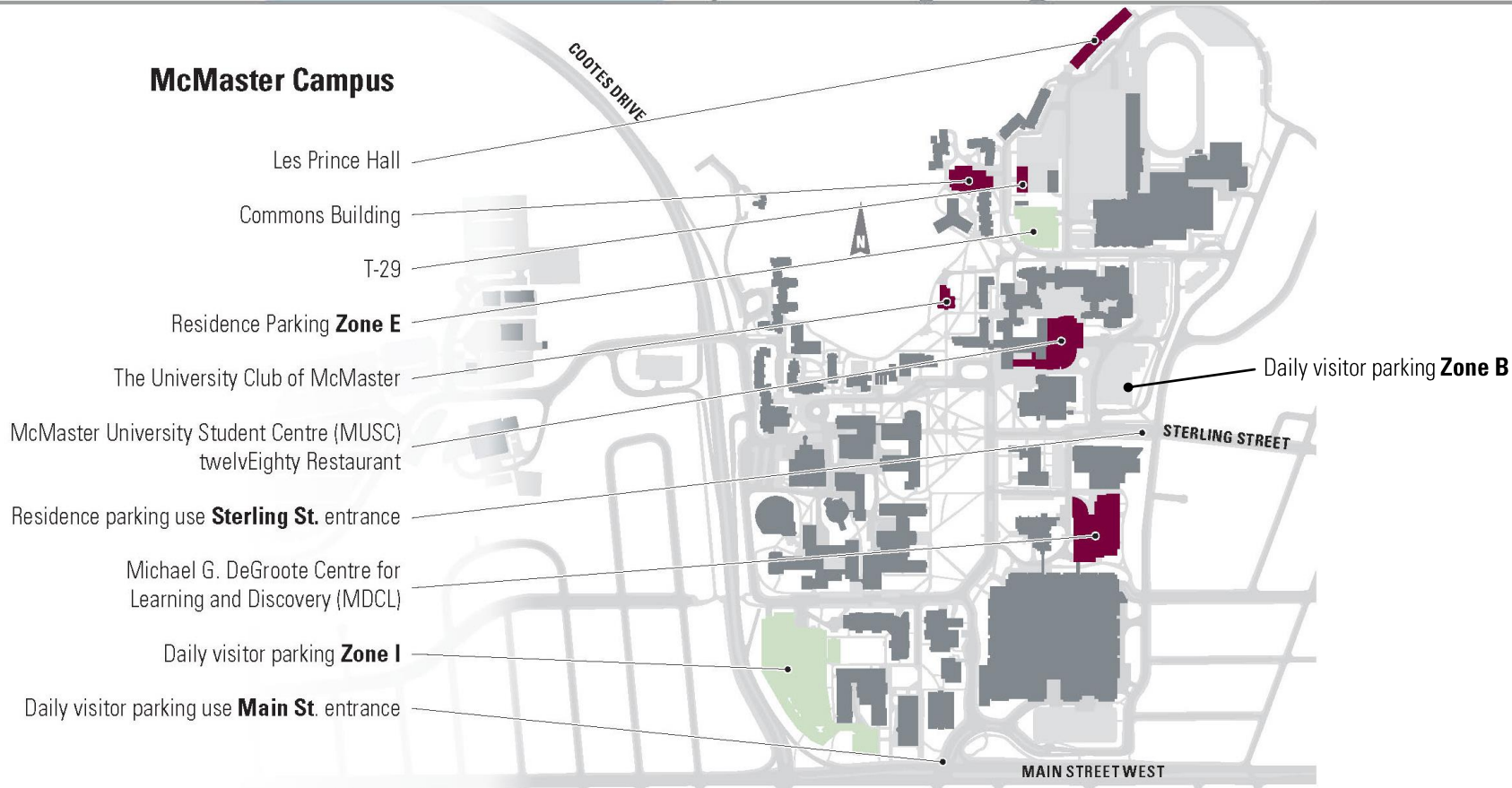
